Hungry Squirrel



1. Use a sharp knife to cut the top off of your pumpkin and remove all of the seeds and pulp. Scrape the sides well so that the interior is relatively dry.
2. To transfer the stencil, cut it out of this sheet by cutting around the stencil. Use packing tape to adhere the stencil to the pumpkin and cover the paper entirely with tape. This will help it stay in place and waterproof the paper.
3. Use pumpkin carving tools to carve the squirrel first, then the acorn, and finally the oak leaves.
4. Remove the stencil from the pumpkin, place a candle inside, and enjoy!

Adult supervision required. Please ask an adult for help when using pumpkin carving tools.
